## Presentation and Q&A - Wilcox Park PickleBall (15 min.)

- A presentation was given on a proposal for a pickleball court and fundraiser at Wilcox Park by Katie Daniels, Mark Daniels, Kristen Moore
- Approached City of GR and had positive initial response
- Identified Stakeholders
  - Friends of GR Parts
  - Grand Rapids Pickleball Association
  - ECA
  - Neighbors
- Been setting up a makeshift pickleball court in the Northerly court
- Expand the court 5' to the east, would allow for 4x full courts (16 people)




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
- Would activate the space
- Ask of the ECA
  - ECA to agree to support the idea and provide a formal letter stating that the ECA is behind this
  - Active involvement from the ECA
    - Getting the word out
    - Recommendations for potential funders
    - Space in the Eastown Newsletter
  - Potentially having the fundraising route through the ECA
    - There is still research being done to see if we can do this and what is needed on the ECA side
    - **ACTION ITEM:** Dakota to confirm ability to take donations through ECA 501c3
    - ACTION ITEM: Dakota to provide info for City matching grant program
    - ACTION ITEM: Kristen and team to provide an entry for the newsletter
  - Money needed for dirt, foundation, resurfacing, and benches
    - Estimate is around \$20K
- No money allocated right now, so looking for funding
  - Grant Application USA Pickleball
  - Look at other companies that work with Pickleball, so there may be some other options available
  - **ACTION ITEM:** Christian to check out with one of his NBA contacts on some potential corporate sponsorship
- GR Pickleball association is fully behind this, and can provide resources and support
  - There may be some opportunities for their organization
- City is onboard to reactivate the space, but not to provide funding
- ECA board will review this and take a vote following the meeting

#### Presentation and Q&A - Sigsbee Park Development (15 min.)

- Long Nguyen, Matt Hull from GRPS facilities
- Working on a Green schoolyard project Sigsbee park
- Natural playground set
- Joint project with GR Parks, working with community went through the full process
  - Put on hold to to Covid and now it is starting back up, but many forgot what had been done
- Project Review
  - 2010-2017 a lot of work done in the Sigsbee park area



- September 2019 community event to get feedback and ideas
- November 2019 2nd round of input and summary
  - Guiding principles
    - Support Community Culture
    - Create a Shared Space
    - Engage with Nature
  - Wanted to keep in mind future use of the school property



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• Phase 1 in yellow above, no funding for Phase 2 yet



- Bikeable space, so the landscape supports biking

#### 4) Financial Report (Treasurer)

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- There is a net revenue of \$4,923.98 as of March 31, 2021. The application for PPP2 was approved for \$9,950. The 2022 CDBG grant application is recommended for approval for \$15,800 for Community Leadership and \$18,000 for Public Safety (similar to 2021) pending public comment and final approval on April 27, 2021. The NPTA (Non-profit Technical Assistant Grant) application was submitted for \$10,000 for DREI Strategic Planning on March 19th.
- There is a cash balance in the bank accounts totalling \$69,589.63 (compared to \$64,544.04 in February) as of April 1, 2021. A separate account has been set up for building maintenance costs. \$500 will automatically transfer from checking to the building account on the 15th of each month.

#### 5) Operating Updates (Executive Director)

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- ECA basement cleanup is scheduled for the first three weekends in May.
- **ACTION ITEM:** Emma will circulate a sign up sheet for cleaning up the basement
- The upstairs tub leak was fixed and the furnace installation and inspection was completed.
- The May/June Access newsletter content deadline is April 16.
- GRPD has assigned new officers as part of strategic planning.
  - All officers will be trained in community policing
  - We'll have 4 community officers that will rotate dates & shifts
  - Main point of contact is the beat Captain John Bylsma
  - There will be more discussions about having some conversations with GRPD and our relationship with them specific to the community policing program
  - Our CDBG funding has some ties to the neighborhood association being a supporter of the local police department. The question becomes how much active "support" do we provide
  - Due to 2020 census changes, we may not necessarily qualify for as much CDBG funding due to changes in neighborhood make-up, etc.
- **ACTION ITEM:** EC to put some information out on Slack about people wanting to help out with the ECA relationship with the GRPD.

• Potentially have the community engagement committee look at options to have the captain attend community meetings.

- A building audit was completed. The EC is working on a building plan to manage maintenance, prioritize repairs, and secure funding.
  - This will be a big fundraising push in the next 12 months
